The "6Cs" of the Safety Culture

Create a positive environment and encourage safe conducts

CONSCIOUSNESS

Observe your surroundings. Identify hazards and consequences and think of how to prevent them: "Stop. Think. Act".



COMMUNICATION

Practice positive communication in order to build, transform, engage and motivate people.



CULTIVATION

Promote knowledge exchange within the organisation on an ascending and descending basis. Collaborative learning reduces risks.



CONSTANCY

Work slow but steady to change beliefs, attitudes and values. This will lead to an increase in safe individual and collective conducts.



CONFIDENCE

Empower employees in order to generate mutual confidence and guarantee safety in a responsible and shared way.



COMMITMENT

Company management must give priority to safety and ensure coherence between what it thinks and what it does. This will enable it to transmit its real commitment to the entire company.
